Types of SOS Memberships - All members receive SOS newsletters and announcements, access to SOS activities, and the appreciation of all so that we can enjoy the watersports at Lakeside.

Annual Membership - Minimum Donation is \$100.00

Annual members can use SOS watercraft (sailboats, kayaks, and paddleboards) during the 2020 season. Please note that there is a two-week waiting period before annual members can begin using SOS watercraft (to avoid conflicts with Lakeside's rental program).

Lifetime Membership (also known as 720 membership) - One-Time Donation of at least \$720.00

Lifetime members can use SOS watercraft (sailboats, kayaks, and paddleboards) during the member's lifetime, and there is no waiting period before they can begin use. The lifetime membership extends to the immediate family, i.e., spouse and children (sorry, does not include grandkids).

New lifetime members will have their name added to the 720 plaque in the Sailing Center.
